Lemtrans paid over UAH 300 million in taxes in the first half of 2024

The total amount of transfers to the budgets of all levels exceeded UAH 300 million. In particular, over UAH 280 million was transferred to the state budget, local budgets were replenished by over UAH 19 million, and the unified social tax reached UAH 19.34 million.
