Kametstal forging machine operators donate over 20,000 brackets to the military for fortifications



The staff of the forging department at Kametstal repair and mechanical shop has been working hard since March 2022 to bring victory closer. In addition to the core products, they make brackets for the construction of military dugouts.

Some did not believe until the last minute that the Russian offensive would start; some had apprehensions and slept restlessly the night before the invasion.
