## Donor's day at FUIB: 30 donors, 13 litres of blood, 90 lives saved



On 14 May [FUIB](#)'s team, in partnership with DonorUA initiative, held Donor's day in Kyiv.

Thirty colleagues donated blood to help the wounded, collecting 13.5 litres of blood in total – enough to potentially save 90 lives. The donation process was supported by medical staff from the Blood Transfusion Department, of Amosov Institute of Cardiovascular Surgery.

As is tradition, **FUIB's Board Chairman** joined the team in donating blood.

*“Our tradition of blood donation at FUIB has been going strong for 10 years - a decade of developing a culture of regular, systemic donation. The need for blood donations has doubled since the full-scale invasion.*
